## **Instructional Sequence**

Grade Level: 3

Subject(s) Area: P.E./Movement

#### Materials Needed:

book "Cloudy With a Chance of Meatballs", sound clip of rain

### Standards:

- 4.1.3 Know how to use space to move safely in different directions, at varying speeds.
- 4.5.1 Use positive social interaction during physical activities.

## **Objectives:**

Students will know how to safely move about the room.

## **Learning Activities:**

- 1. Read the book "Cloudy With a Chance of Meatballs".
- 2. Discuss the book:

What was their favorite part? Why?

3. Movement activity:

Have sound clip of rain ready.

Explain to the students the rules of the game:

When the rain starts, students will walk around pretending to hold an umbrella and when the sound stops they stop. Whoever does not stop sits down. Play until everyone is sitting

### **Assessment:**

Students will be assessed on good sportsmanship and participation.
